Range Membership

The dues for each member shall be on an annual basis, beginning January 1st and ending December 31st of each year.

The following rates apply:

- Individual - \$250.00 (Must be 18 or older)
- Couples - \$375.00 (Must reside at the same address)
- Family - \$425.00 (Children must be 21 or younger)

All memberships are for 12 months and subject to sales tax.

The first seventy-five (75) members will be considered "Charter Member". This will be determined by date their application was submitted.

A member who is in arrears in dues by thirty (30) days shall not be eligible to enjoy any of the privileges or benefits of Leatherneck Shooters Range and shall be dropped from the rolls after forty-five (45) days and must reapply for (initial) membership.

Prospective members may apply by submitting a properly completed application.

Personal qualities of prospective members include maturity, honesty; integrity; patriotism; the ability to work well with others; a person not given to violent, unsafe, or disruptive behavior; not being involved in drunkenness or illegal drug use; and thereby contribute to the betterment of the organization.

Applicants must pay the fees and dues that are in effect at the time their membership is accepted. Additionally, applicants must be legally able to own, possess and utilize firearms in the State of Missouri.

Any member who does not display sportsman like conduct or who performs activities which are detrimental to Leatherneck Shooters shall be subject to expulsion or having their membership suspended or revoked.

Any suspension, revocation or expulsion shall become effective immediately. The term of suspension expulsion shall be no less than thirty (30) days.

Range Rules

VIOLATION OF ANY RANGE RULES MAY RESULT IN THE REMOVAL FROM THE RANGE AND/OR SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF MEMBERSHIP.

ALL FIREARMS WILL REMAIN POINTED DOWN RANGE OR IN A SAFE DIRECTION AT ALL TIMES.

A Range Safety Officer (RSO) will be on the range at any time the range is in use and in charge of the range.

The Range Safety Officer (RSO) **WILL** eject from the range, any person handling a firearm in an unsafe manner.

Obey all Range Safety Officer commands at all times.

Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

A valid picture ID is required to enter the range.

COMMENCE FIRING: on this command you may begin firing when ready.

CEASE FIRE: this command can be called by **ANYONE** observing an unsafe situation.

- **ALL SHOOTING STOPS IMMEDIATELY**
- **SHOOTERS TAKE FINGER OFF TRIGGER, KEEP GUN POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION, AND WAIT FOR INSTRUCTIONS FROM RANGE SAFETY OFFICER.**

No one shall go forward of the firing line unless directed by the Range Safety Officer.

Eye and ear protection must be worn at all times while on the range.

Do not use drugs or alcohol while shooting.

No food or beverages are allowed in the shooting area.

Loading or unloading your firearm is only allowed on the firing line with the muzzle pointed down range.

Keep fingers off the trigger and outside the trigger guard until ready to shoot.

Shoot only at authorized targets.

Armor piercing, tracer or incendiary ammunition is prohibited.

You may not shoot if you have been using alcohol or any other substance that would impair your ability to shoot a firearm.

When leaving the firing line at any time unload your firearm, lock the action open and keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.

Full autos are allowed; all shooters must be certified by the facility prior to use.

If your firearm malfunctions, becomes jammed, or if you require assistance of any kind from the Range Safety Officer, keep the muzzle pointed down range and raise your non-firing hand and wait for assistance from the Range Safety Officer. At no time should you attempt to remove a loaded or jammed firearm from the firing line.

Non-shooters may not enter the range area.

Wash your hands after shooting.
